They will work closely with CEN leadership, staff, and partners to identify, recruit, and integrate the next President in a way that builds long-term organizational strength.

#### **Scope of Work**

The strategic partner will provide comprehensive services in four phases:

## 1. Profile Development

- Facilitate stakeholder engagement sessions (staff, board, partners, and community) to gather input on priorities for the next President.
- Develop a detailed leadership profile aligned with CEN's mission, vision, and job description.
- Establish core competencies, cultural attributes, and leadership qualities required for success.

#### 2. Search & Recruitment

- Develop a compelling job posting and coordinate with the CEN Marketing team to develop search materials based on the candidate profile.
- Advise on posting and distribution strategy to maximize reach among diverse and highly qualified candidates.
- Manage candidate outreach and interest cultivation, drawing on a broad network of education and nonprofit leaders.
- Provide regular updates and progress reports to CEN leadership.

### 3. Screening & Selection

- Conduct initial candidate screening, including résumé review, preliminary interviews, and alignment with profile criteria.
- Present a diverse slate of top candidates for CEN Leadership's consideration.

- Advise CEN on interview structures, evaluation tools, and decision-making processes.
- Provide guidance on candidate reference checks, including sample questions and best practices.

## 4. Onboarding & Strategic Integration

- Develop an onboarding support plan in collaboration with CEN leadership to ensure smooth transition.
- Advise on a 90-day integration roadmap to align the new President with staff, partners, and organizational priorities.
- Provide recommendations for communication strategies to announce and welcome the new President.

#### **Deliverables**

The selected partner will deliver:

- Candidate leadership profile report.
- Finalized job posting and distribution plan.
- Slate of qualified, vetted candidates.
- Screening reports and reference check guidance.
- Onboarding and integration support plan.
- Ongoing consultation and facilitation as needed through the successful hiring of the President.

## **Proposal Requirements**

Interested partners should include the following in their proposals:

- 1. **Organizational Background** history, size, and relevant expertise in executive searches within education, nonprofit, or mission-driven organizations.
- 2. **Approach & Methodology** description of your process for candidate profiling, recruitment, screening, and onboarding.
- 3. **Team** profiles of key staff who will manage the search.
- 4. **Experience** examples of similar searches conducted, especially in education or nonprofit sectors.
- 5. **Timeline** estimated project timeline from initiation to successful placement.
- 6. **Cost Proposal** itemized fee structure, including any anticipated expenses.

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Demonstrated expertise and experience in executive search.
- Understanding of CEN's mission and unique organizational needs.

- Inclusivity and diversity in candidate recruitment.
- Quality of methodology and deliverables.
- Cost-effectiveness and value.
- Strength of references and prior results.
